	2. Avoid crowding - allow appropriate floor space for each animal according to breed and size.
	3. Clean water vessels and make sure fresh water is always available to the animal.
	4. Construct hutch floor of wire for cleanliness.
	5. Remove all manure and filth from rabbitry each week.
	6. Use appropriate feeders and clean when necessary.
	7. Provide some greens occasionally.
	8. Feed hay periodically in a manger for cleanliness and economy.
	9. If breeding, keep records accurately: Hutch card (indicated on page 4).
	10. Consider using rabbit meat for use in your home to become familiar with the quality. (Low fat/Cholesterol and High protein)
