Kathy will talk to Gerard to try to solve the issue. The Haunt committee needs to make sure the bathroom is cleaned and locked at the end of the night.

Aaron sent the paperwork for the taxes in. He will be stepping down as Co-Treasurer in Oct 2018.

Roger put together an inventory of the storage shed. He also stated that the Historical Committee is looking for new options to sell bricks. Thoughts were to ask non-4-H people and possible buyers at the large and small animal auctions.

The Constitution Committee met and have a draft together.

Three SMART goals were formed.

1. Having trained successor for the outgoing co-treasurer by Nov 2018.
2. To connect with more 4-H alumni by creating a new twitter account and Facebook account by 25% by June 2018.
3. Increase county-wide projects by two projects for 2017-2018 year.
