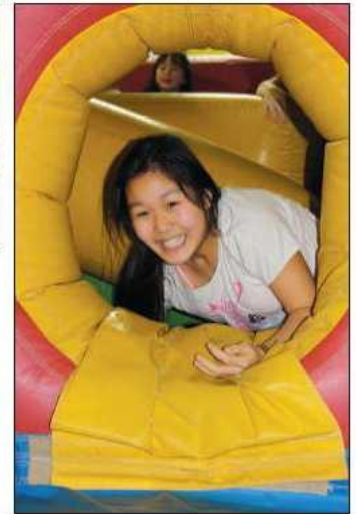


# Bouncing through the century
