Charlie Daniels, 4-H fun and more

Grammy Award-winning musician to headline Ozaukee County Fair that returns Aug. 3 with bounty of family attractions

A nationally known country act, a popular musician across Wisconsin and a new opportunity for youth highlight the entertainment at this year's Ozaukee County Fair.

The fair runs Wednesday, Aug. 3, through Sunday, Aug. 7, at the fairgrounds in Cedarburg. Admission is free.

The Grammy Award-winning Charlie Daniels Band will headline the Grandstand Stage at 7:30 p.m. Friday, Aug. 5, with special guest The WhiskeyBelles from Milwaukee.

The Charlie Daniels Band, which has been performing since 1972, is best known for hits like "The Devil Went Down to Georgia," "Long Haired Country Boy," "The South's Gonna Do It Again," "In America" and "The Legend of Wooley Swamp."

Born in 1936 in Wilmington, N.C., Daniels recorded his first solo album in 1970. He was inducted into the Country Music Hall of Fame this year.

The rest of the band includes Bruce Brown on lead guitar, Charlie Hayward on bass guitar, Chris Wormer on guitar, Shannon Wickline on keyboards and Ron Gannaway on drums. Tickets prices are \$35 for VIP and \$20 for general admission seats.

Singer-songwriter Pat McCurdy will perform on the 5 corners Centre Stage on from

7:30 to 10:45 p.m. Wednesday, Aug. 3.

McCurdy, from Milwaukee, is well known across the state and the Midwest for his musical performances. He taught himself to play guitar and fronted several bands before going solo. He performs often all over Wisconsin and in Chicago and Minneapolis.

New this year is a Kiddie Power Wheels class in the demolition derby competition. Children ages 4 to 11 will compete in their small vehicles in a demo derby.

They may also decorate their cars. The fanciest car wins an award, as will the one with the most hits.

"They don't wreck them like they do a car, but every time you bump, we're going to count them and build up points," Jimmy Pipkorn, derby promoter and former participant, said.

The children's derby will be held at 1 p.m. Sunday in a 30-by-30-foot track on the grass in front of the grandstand. The bus demo derby starts at 2 p.m., followed by the finals.

Saturday's demo derby starts at 6 p.m. Pipkorn said he is trying to increase attendance at the fair on Sunday. Once the derby moved from Friday and Saturday nights to

Saturday and Sunday — since a band is the main entertainment Friday — he said, attendance has fallen. The derby used to be full to the point of turning people away. Now, plenty of seats are available.

Entries have declined too, from 300 to 150, he said.

"We had a lot more drivers before Cash for Clunkers came," Pipkorn said.

But fewer participants in the finals makes for faster-moving cars.

"I like that better because your crowd gets a lot better show when there's fewer contestants. If 20 cars are running at once, you don't build up speed and hit as heavy," Pipkorn

said.

Tickets for each demo derby on Saturday and Sunday cost \$12 for adults and \$6 for children ages 3 to 12.

The annual tractor and truck pull will be held at 6 p.m. Wednesday. Adult tickets are \$8 and children ages 3 to 12, \$4.

The only other event requiring admission is the second annual Barryard 5-kilometer run/walk. The cost for participants age 12 and up is \$25 and those younger than 12 pay \$15. Proceeds benefit the fair.

The run/walk goes from 8 to 11:30 a.m. Sunday.
