Beef - Steve Rathke

- Blue Sheet needs to be completed by weigh in
- Wednesday 4-7 pm
- In order to sell:
 - Grade low choice
 - Max payout 1450# Beef, 1600# Dairy Beef

- Show ring - Superintendent, under the fair board, is in charge of lining up the help for the show. If you can't show because both animals are in the same class, you can have another beef member show, however, it must be the same level in 4H, must be approved by Steve. Same applies to exhibitors that may be injured. Make him aware of who may be showing your animal, he has final approval.

Sheep - Bob & Mari Schmidt

- Thank you Heather Hamm to bring sheep and Sarah Reimer for showmanship
- Wednesday Weigh in (time)
- In order to sell you must grade at Average Choice and maximum payout is at 160 #
- Scrapie ear tags are necessary (Bob) -- market ewe lambs and all sheep over 12 months of age.

Swine - Jim Hoerchner

- Ear tags --- if you are missing one, contact Jim right away.
- Pigs must be 220# to show at fair, max payout 295# with a grade of 2
- Blue sheets must be filled in on weigh in night
- Vet papers must accompany the animals off the trailer. Vet checks must be done within 30 days of the fair.
