

**OZAUKEE COUNTY 4-H SHOOTING SPORTS
PROGRAM CODE OF CONDUCT**

As a participant, you have the responsibility of representing the Ozaukee County 4-H organization to the public and so you are expected to conduct yourself in a manner that will bring honor to you and your family as well as to Ozaukee County 4-H. To do that you will need to:

1. Attend all sessions in the planned program or notify a leader if you are unable to attend.
2. Follow hours, facility and range rules. You are responsible to know those rules.
3. Use good judgment in selecting clothing appropriate to the occasion and the weather. This is an all weather sport, so please dress for the weather.
4. Use language and manner that will bring respect to the program.
5. Be in the assigned program area at all times.
6. Follow Ozaukee County 4-H's driving policy in regard to all events and activities.
7. Know that the use of alcohol, tobacco and non-prescribed drugs is illegal and is expressly prohibited at all events. You should inform adult leaders of the use of any prescription medications.
8. Show courtesy and respect for all other persons. Demonstrate good sportsmanship.
9. Treat program areas, lodging areas and vehicles with respect and care. You will be responsible for any damage, theft or misconduct in which you participate.
10. Help other member in the program have a pleasant experience by making every attempt to include all participants in activities.
11. Live up to your highest expectations for yourself so you can return home proud of who you are and what you have done. ***Those who find themselves unable to conduct themselves within the guidelines listed above may expect:***
 - To explain their actions to the adult leaders
 - To accept the consequences of their actions
 - To have the adult leaders work closely with parents/guardians, UW Extension personnel, Ozaukee County 4-H personnel and others to see that appropriate and logical actions and responses are taken in case of unacceptable behavior
 - May be required to appear before the Ozaukee County 4-H Leader Executive Board as per behavior guidelines
