The party checking out the kits assumes all responsibility for any attendees' use of the kits for the duration of their check out request, and agrees to abide by the following conditions of accepting full responsibility of the Robotic kits checked out to them and does not expire until the Robotics kits and all parts are check in with Ozaukee County.

These terms and conditions are only in effect for the dates requested per the Check-Out request, and do not extend to any past or future reservations.

Henceforth, the Robotics Kit(s), Laptop(s), and all accessories will be referred to as "Kits", unless other specified.

The individual/county checking out the Kits assumes all responsibility for any attendees of any events where the Kits are utilized and agrees to abide by the following conditions:

- As the Educator, you are responsible for the condition of the kits and laptops at all times.
- If any pieces are in need of replacement or repair, whether lost, stolen, or damaged; during the duration of the request (from pick-up to drop-of), the party checking them out is responsible for any costs associated.
- The kits will not be left unattended.
- The kits will be returned on time, as reserved. If at any time you need to change the reservation request, please contact Ozaukee County UWEX immediately so that the schedule can accommodate changes.
- The party checking out the kits is responsible for picking up and returning the kits, and arranging for any transportation of delivery of the kits as necessary.
- All kits must be disassembled prior to returning them to the Ozaukee county UWEX office, and an inventory must be completed/signed off. If any parts are found missing/damaged and no inventory was completed, the party checking the kits out may be held responsible. (Part list included)
- Charging and better use of the Mindstorm Kits must be read and accepting this agreement constitutes that they are understood.
- No computer hardware, software, or settings will be added, deleted, or altered on any of the laptops at any time.
- Internet is NOT to be used on any of the laptops.
- We recommend that there are no more than two people working on a kit/laptop at a time.
- In order for all kits to work, they require a laptop with the robotics program.
- WeDo kits are created for youth 7-12, NXT Mindstorm kits are created for youth middle school through high school.
- All terms and conditions must be followed, as stated on the check-out agreement.
