#### **Public Transit**

Ozaukee County Transit offers Ozaukee County Express bus service along I-43 and Shared-Ride taxi service throughout the county (www.ozaukeetransit.com).

#### Multi-Use Trail

The Ozaukee Interurban Trail, a 30-mile paved trail, the majority of which is off-road, runs through the Town of Port Washington and provides opportunities for biking, in-line skating, walking, running, and cross-country skiing.

#### Air

Commercial airline service is available at:

- Milwaukee's General Mitchell International Airport (33 miles south)
- Chicago's O'Hare International Airport (104 miles south)

#### Rail

Area rail freight service is provided by Union Pacific Railroad. Passenger rail service, provided by Amtrak, is available at the Milwaukee Intermodal Station, 26 miles south.

- Port of Milwaukee: 29 miles south

### **Amenities**

The Town of Port Washington, located north and west of the City of Port Washington, is a rural community that enjoys the beauty of its Lake Michigan shoreland, woodland, and farmland.

Interstate Highway 43 provides easy access to Milwaukee, Sheboygan, and Green Bay.

Recreational opportunities include the Ozaukee Interurban Trail, which runs through the Town and nearby Harrington Beach State Park to the north.
