Ozaukee County 4-H Foundation

The Ozaukee County 4-H Foundation, founded in 1982, exists to provide essential support for the ongoing needs of the Ozaukee County 4-H Youth Development program. The Foundation's Board of Directors raise funds and manage an endowment to support the continued success and longevity of the Ozaukee County 4-H program. Gifts are invested in perpetuity, and investment income each year supports the Ozaukee County 4-H program. In 2018, \$21,700 will be distributed to 4-H youth through higher education scholarships, adult leader training, summer camp, and to support youth attending region, state, national, and international 4-H experiences. The Foundation endowment currently invests about \$400,000. These funds have been accumulated through:

- Gifts given in memory of loved ones or in honor of friends of 4-H
- Individual giving
- Corporate giving
- Workplace giving
- Fundraisers such as the Bowl-a-thon and Change War Wagon

Many corporations match donations made by employees to a wide range of nonprofits, to support employee charitable giving, and to reward volunteer service. If your employer has this type of program, please consider naming the Ozaukee County 4-H Foundation for your matching grant. The Foundation's EIN is 39-1724064.

This Foundation Bowl-a-thon has taken place for over 30 years. The first was held in 1986 and raised pledges totaling \$2,542 from 54 bowlers. In 2017 bowl-a-thon raised \$8,590 with 261 bowlers. The 2018 Bowl-a-thon will happen soon. Here are the details:

Each club is allowed up to 3 (three) acts. If the club has more than 60 members, the club is allowed 1 (one) additional act for every 20 (twenty) members. Example: If your club has 115 members, it is allowed 2 additional acts for a total of 5 acts.

Show Animals at State Fair

Youth interested in showing market beef, sheep, swine, OR breeding stock commercial heifers/crossbred gilts/ wether type ewes at the 2018 Wisconsin State Fair Junior Show will need to have their animal projects DNA and RFID identified by the State Fair eligibility deadlines listed below. This identification system allows animals which are DNA and RFID identified through the Wisconsin Livestock Identification Consortium (WLIC) County and State Fair program to meet State Fair Identification requirements if the process is completed (all forms returned and samples on file) by the Wisconsin State Fair identification deadline postmarks listed.

Market Beef, Sheep, and Swine DNA and RFID identification deadlines (postmark):

Beef: Tuesday - February 13, 2018 Sheep: Tuesday - May 8, 2018 Swine: Tuesday - May 8, 2018

Breeding stock: commercial heifers/crossbred gilts/ wether type ewes or any purebred animal being shown in the commercial, crossbred or wether type divisions

DNA and RFID identification deadline (postmark):

Wednesday - June 6, 2018 (postmark)

Ozaukee County 4-H Foundation Scholarship Opportunity

The Ozaukee County 4-H Foundation will make several scholarships available for active Ozaukee County 4-H members who are in their 2018 high school graduating senior class, or one year past high school, with at least five years of 4-H club membership. Applicants must have fulfilled all 4-H achievement requirements in that year. Once an applicant is awarded a scholarship, they are not eligible to re-apply. Accredited technical and college degree programs are acceptable for application.

No application materials will be accepted at the 4-H office. Mailing options, along with the updated 2018 application will be available on the 4-H <u>Forms page</u> or the <u>Foundation page</u> of the 4-H website in January. Please keep an eye out for details.

Wisconsin 4-H Foundation Scholarship Opportunity

The Wisconsin 4-H Foundation will award more than \$10,000 in scholarships to outstanding Wisconsin students pursuing higher education in 2018.

To be eligible for Wisconsin 4-H Foundation scholarships, students must have been a 4-H member for at least one year, have a grade point average of at least 2.5 on a 4.0 scale, and be enrolled or planning to enroll at a university, college or technical school during the 2018-2019 academic school year.

In Honor of Janice Bublitz's induction into the Wisconsin 4-H Hall of Fame from Tamie Koop Janice's favorite areas to teach were nature, music, drama, and the youngest 4-H members. She was the county's 4-H Summer Camp Lead Naturalist at Upham Woods Outdoor Learning Center for more than a decade, working to develop youth staff into camp naturalists who could teach their own camper programs. Janice's



early work with the younger brothers and sisters in her 4-H Club became mini-4-H long before the Cloverbud Program. Her leadership to transition to the 4-H Variety Show format gave every youth the opportunity to be on stage, a tradition that lives on.

Janice trained in state programs and successfully implemented them in her county, including Youth Volunteers in Motion, the Volunteer Force, and the Youth Protection Program. Her ability to work with youth and adult leaders in these leadership experiences set a direction for the youth-adult partnerships valued today.

Almost until her passing, Janice remained an active 4-H leader in the Ozaukee County 4-H program. She was passionate about 4-H and humble. Her leadership in so many 4-H programs and activities, which continue today, built a stronger 4-H Program for Ozaukee County 4-H members, families, and leaders.
