

Ozaukee County 4-H Livestock Association Agreement

YOUTH PARTICIPATING ONE YEAR BEYOND HIGH SCHOOL:

Youth who are living at home or in the local area and attending college or working, are required to follow the attendance guidelines for Association meeting attendance, along with the remaining club achievement requirements.

Youth who are attending college away from the local area, must attend a minimum of 2 general meetings, more if possible, and other Association requirements. Youth must carry out a leadership role prearranged with the Association board in writing no later than November 1st. The leadership role can be completed at any time during the 4-H year. Youth are expected to do their own project work, participate in county fair or make a public display of their project work and complete a record book to complete achievement.

The agreement does not change or alter requirements of the 4-H Club, organizations or associations.
