



## Become a 4-H Volunteer!

We welcome all new volunteers and thank you for your willingness to serve in this capacity. 4-H takes steps to ensure a safe and healthy environment for youth and encourages safeguards for adult leaders. There is a 4-step process to become a registered volunteer:

1. Register in [www.4Honline.com](http://www.4Honline.com). If members of your family are already in 4-H, simply add yourself to your family's profile.
2. Attend a New Volunteer Orientation. After registering in 4Honline, we'll send you an e-mail with the date of the next orientation which takes about 90 minutes. This training must be completed prior to the Shooting Sports Training.
3. Complete an online mandated child abuse/neglect reporter training which take about 45 minutes.
4. Respond to an e-mail authorizing a background check.

## Shooting Sports Leader Certification

A statewide Shooting Sports Leader Certification workshop will be held to teach leaders how to conduct safe, supervised, shooting experiences for 4-H members enrolled in shooting sports projects and to complete required leader certification.

**A Wisconsin 4-H Shooting Sports Leader may be certified in the following disciplines:**

- Archery
- Coordinator
- Muzzleloader
- Pistol
- Rifle/Air Rifle
- Shotgun



Leaders may only teach in the discipline in which they are certified. An adult leader cannot provide hands-on or safety instruction without a certified leader supervising the range.

### 2019 Certification Workshop

**Workshop overview:** All certification workshops are 6-10 pm Friday and 8 am to 5 pm Saturday. You must participate in all required hours to receive your certification. Those attending for the first time must complete the Friday night and Saturday sessions. Those returning for an additional certification need only attend their Saturday range workshop providing three (3) years has not lapsed since attending the Friday session.

**The Ozaukee County 4-H Foundation will reimburse leaders for the registration cost of the workshop. Cost:**

**\$70**—Includes instructor manuals, equipment, ammunition, Friday pm snack, Saturday lunch, and Saturday am and pm snacks, **or**

**\$55**—Saturday discipline-only

**\*Reduced Fee for one spouse if both spouses attend same workshop/discipline:** \$25 (When both spouses attend the same certification workshop taking the same discipline the \$25 rate for one spouse applies. \$70+\$25=\$95 or \$55+\$25=\$80.)
