Cover Story: What is Your SPARK?



When asked the question "what is your spark?" I hope you can immediately respond. According to the <u>Search Institute</u> a spark is a "special quality, skill, or interest that lights us up and that we are passionate about. It is something that comes from inside of us, and when we express it, it gives us joy and energy. It's our very essence, the thing about us that is good and beautiful, and useful to the world."

4-H may be your spark or where you found your spark. As a 4-H volunteer leader, you are a "spark champion". You can affirm a youth's spark. Provide opportunities to express it, eliminate obstacles, teach, and mentor.

Generally, according to the <u>Search Institute</u> "there are three types of sparks, something you are good at – a talent or skill, something you care deeply about – such as the environment or serving your community, or a quality you know is special – caring for others or being a friend."

When youth know their spark and have several adults who support their spark, they are more likely to have a sense of purpose, be socially competent, physically healthy, help others and have greater school success.

Sparks can change over time and young people need multiple champions to teach and cheer them on.

I invite all current and future youth and adult leaders (spark champions) to attend the Annual Leader Training on March 26 OR April 23, from 6:00-9:00 pm in the Auditorium

New Volunteer Orientation Dates

We welcome new adult volunteers and thank you for your willingness to serve in this capacity.

4-H takes steps to ensure a safe and healthy environment for youth and encourages safeguards for adult leaders. Each new volunteer is required to attend one session of new volunteer orientation. Volunteers who have not enrolled in the last five years must also be retrained. New volunteer process includes the following:

- Complete the online enrollment form which includes a Volunteer Behavior Agreement (4H Online)
- Participate in a New Volunteer Orientation (in person session)


- Authorize a background check (4H Online)
- Complete Mandated Reporter Training (online session)

Ozaukee County 4-H Older Youth Crew (OYC) News




• February 16, 2020: Pinewood Derby Race Day - race your derby car!

Ozaukee County 4-H Foundation Scholarship Opportunity

The Ozaukee County 4-H Foundation will make several scholarships available for active Ozaukee County 4-H members who are in their 2019 high school graduating senior class, or one year past high school, with at least five years of 4-H club membership. Applicants must have fulfilled all 4-H achievement requirements in that year. Once an applicant is awarded a scholarship, they are not eligible to re-apply. Accredited technical and college degree programs are acceptable for application.

No application materials will be accepted at the 4-H office. Mailing options, along with the updated 2020 application are available on the <u>FORMS</u> page of the website. Postmark deadline is March 6th.
