The fair will have two consecutive nights of tractor and truck pulling on Wednesday and Thursday at 7 p.m.

The first night will feature five classes of trucks and tractors. The second night will feature six classes of trucks and tractors. Tractor classes will be: Modified, Too-Hot-To-Farm and PI Hot Farm Tractors.

Registration and weigh-in starts at 3 p.m. and will end at 6:30 p.m. All tractors and trucks must enter at Gate 1, at the south end of the fairgrounds, off Washington Avenue.

On Friday and Saturday, demolition derbies return to the fair, as well.

Daily kids' activities and arts and crafts will take place daily inside the Blain's Farm & Fleet 4-H Entertainment South Expo from 10 a.m. to 7 p.m. Wednesday through Saturday and 1 p.m. to 6 p.m. Sunday.

Families can stop by and try their hand at milking a cow and enjoy other agricultural activities during the fair.

Fairgoers should also be on the lookout for a pig to win big. Each day a giant, stuffed pig will be around the fairgrounds. Get a photo with the pig and share it on Facebook and Instagram with the hashtags #ozaukeecountyfair and #olsenspiggly-wiggly for a chance at one of two gift cards awarded daily.

Fairgoers should also pick up a Scavenger Hunt form, located outside the fair office and mailboxes throughout the grounds, to enter daily drawings for cash and prizes that will be on display in the Bruce Krier Foundation Exhibit Building North Expo.

And what fair would be complete without the cream puffs? The 4-H will be selling cream puffs at the Clover Cafe throughout the fair.

On Sunday, the Wisconsin 4-H Key Awards will be presented during the fair at noon in the Blain's Farm & Fleet 4-H Entertainment North Expo. Five youths from the surrounding areas and communities will be awarded this highest 4-H honor.
