The 4-H Premium Book is available on the Ozaukee County Fair website:

<https://www.ozaukeecountyfair.com/4-h-open-class-school-art-entries> Please read your project area(s) carefully! **On-Line entry in ShoWorks is open until July 1st, 2022!**

There have also been changes to the Judging Schedule, most notably with non-animal judging (static) projects taking place on **Thursday July 28th and Friday July 29th from 1-6pm**. Please read the schedule carefully, as not to miss any deadlines/judging times! <https://www.ozaukeecountyfair.com/judging-schedule>

Also, judging for all static 4-H Exhibits will take place in the Ascension Columbia St. Mary's Expo Center (Curling Building). The 4-H Dog Demonstration will take place on Saturday August 6th at 1pm, and the 4-H Style Revue will take place on Saturday, August 6th at 6pm, both on the stage in the Expo Center.

*The Fair will also offer 4-H exhibitors who do not feel comfortable with static project face-to-face judging the option to drop off their entries with an accompanying form (similar to the 2020 and 2021 form) for each project entered. These projects must have entry tags attached and dropped off on Thursday, July 28 from 1-6pm. The accompanying form is available on our website, or by clicking here:

FAIR ENTRY INFORMATION

Please visit our website: <https://www.ozaukeecountyfair.com/> Again, please pay special attention to the 4-H Premium Book to be sure you chose the correct Department and Class.

ShoWorks online entry system has been part of the Ozaukee County Fair for well over a decade. Since most exhibitors have now had several years of experience using online entries the Ozaukee County Fair will **ONLY** allow exhibitors that are correctly entered in the correct class to exhibit their project(s) at the Fair. To help avoid mistakes in using the online entry system, we have listed some useful tips below:

1) Always begin your entries by reading the Fair Premium Book. This is available online, or by downloading this pdf: https://www.ozaukeecountyfair.com/files/ugd/5d0b9f_8d2b0ea4aed349579816f978d84536b9.pdf as well as at Ozaukee County Libraries and the UW Extension Office. This is a 3 year book. Find the classes you want to enter in using the Premium Book prior to using the online entry system.

2) Access the ShoWorks online entry system using the link from the Ozaukee County Fair website. Start any entry with your personal information by clicking on “Register” near the top of the screen. Please enter the exhibitor’s first and last name and select “I am a new exhibitor”. 4-H and Open Class exhibitors must register as a “NEW EXHIBITOR” every year. We do **not** save your account from previous years. 4-H and Open Class exhibitors **MUST** complete information including name, mailing address, day-time phone number, and club name when prompted to provide. If you are not a member of a 4-H club, select “Open Class” under club name. The program does not automatically take you to “Open Class” or 4-H Departments.

3) When entering, make sure the class number you are selecting online exactly matches the class number in the Premium Book. All 4-H class numbers begin with 4, all open class numbers begin with 3, and all senior class numbers begin with 62. Please verify that you have entered in the correct department.

4) When you have finished entering, **PRINT YOUR RECEIPT!** Read your receipt to verify you entered into all the correct classes. Bring it along to the Fair to pick up your entry tags. This is your proof that you entered correctly.

5) All 4-H, Open Class, and Senior entries must be completed **by July 1. No late entries will be accepted.**
Submit Your Fair Entries—**July 1st Deadline!**

6) Deliver your items on the date specified in the Fair Judging Schedule. No late or early deliveries will be accepted. Please only enter projects that you actually intend to bring to the Fair. Remember, no more than one entry per class is allowed.

7) The Ozaukee County Fair is requiring Premise ID numbers for any animal entries (except dogs & rabbits). In Summary:

- **On-line entries for 4-H are open!**
- **Entries are due July 1st– No Exceptions!!!**
- **No entry = No Show!!!**
- **Print your receipt!!**
- **All 4-H numbers start with a 4!!!**
- **Premise ID Numbers are required for animal projects (except dogs & rabbits) when entering.**
- **Don’t wait until the last minute to enter.**

ANIMAL EXHIBITORS (Beef, Sheep, Swine, Dairy, Horses, Goats & Poultry):

Additional forms will again be required for all Livestock Exhibitors (Dairy, Beef, Swine, Sheep, Goat, Horse and Poultry). This is to ensure that all exhibitors are compliant with Animal Health Certification Requirements for Wisconsin DATCP. Forms must be completed and turned in to the appropriate Animal Superintendent (or their designee) upon check-in at the Fair. Exhibitors that do not comply, will not be allowed to exhibit at the Fair and the animal(s) will not be allowed on the grounds. **Poultry Exhibitors: We are carefully monitoring the status of Avian Influenza throughout Wisconsin. You may enter your birds/eggs and Showmanship as you normally would (by July 1). If there are confirmed cases within 30 days of our Fair, we may need to cancel the show for health & safety concerns. Educational Exhibits will be judged/displayed regardless of the status of the Avian Influenza. Please stay tuned for updates.*

FOODS JUDGING

The date has been set for Foods Judging, combining with other non-animal 4-H exhibits. Judging is prior to the Fair and includes the following projects:

- Foods & Nutrition
- Candy Making
- Preservation
- Themed Dining Experience (Formerly Foods Revue)
- Cake Decorating
- Date: Friday, July 29th
- Time: **1:00pm – 6:00pm**
- Location: Ascension Columbia St. Mary's Expo Center

Please note that cake decorating projects judged during Foods judging will also be allowed to be displayed at the Ozaukee County Fair. Members need to let Carol Boehlke or Patti Wilhelme know at Foods Judging if they decide to leave their items to be displayed the Fair.

iPad TRAINING/REFRESHER

PICNIC TABLES & BENCHES

The Ozaukee County Agricultural Society is offering personalized picnic tables and benches again this year, that will be used during the Ozaukee County Fair.
