When it is expressed, we feel alive. We feel useful. Life has a purpose. We feel we are drawing on our best potential.

Sending my appreciation and gratitude to all the 4-H volunteers that attended the 2022-2023 Annual Leader Training! Three trainings were held in January. Participants discussed and defined "sparks", looked at the Thrive Survey results and the why behind our focus on youth's sparks. We identified 4-H volunteers as Spark Champions and ways they can share their sparks and help youth identify their sparks. The Thriving 4-H Model was shared and how sparks help create the right environment to encourage growth. Each 4-H volunteer attending the Annual Leader Training received a copy of the book Sparks: How Parents Can Ignite the Hidden Strengths of Teenagers, by Peter L. Benson, supported by the Ozaukee County 4-H Leaders Association. Along with the book resources were provided enabling the volunteer to hold a book read or train someone to hold a three-session book read. Books are available to be checked out from Extension for 30 days by a club holding the book read. Facilitator guides for each session are available from the Extension office to support those interested in holding a book read or reading the book.
