

# 2024 Base Camp Packing List

## BE SURE TO LABEL ALL ITEMS WITH YOUR NAME

- Day pack (A small to medium sized backpack would work, or a drawstring bag)
- Reusable water bottle (make sure it is labeled with your name)
- Rain jacket/poncho
- Closed toed shoes
- Jacket/sweatshirt
- Swimsuit (one-piece or two-piece w/T-shirt)
- Flashlight
- Sleeping Bag
- Air Mattress - optional (twin size only)
- Pillow
- Pen/pencil
- Sharpie
- Small notebook
- Watch
- Sunglasses
- Hat
- Garden Gloves
- Towel - for water activities
- Towel for bathing
- Personal hygiene items (soap, shampoo, toothbrush/paste, brush or comb, deodorant, etc.)
- Bug spray - non-aerosol (will not be provided by camp staff)
- Sunscreen - non-aerosol (will not be provided by camp staff)
- Deck of cards/other forms of group entertainment
- Change of clothes for each day
- Plan to wear layers each day
- Shoes for walking/hiking (not crocs/flip flops etc.)
- Closed toe water shoes if you want to wear them to and from or in the lake.
- Plastic bag (to place wet or dirty items in)
- Other items for your specific needs

## What **not** to bring:

- Laser pointer
- Aerosols
- Knives or weapons
- Lighters or matches
- Fireworks
- Candy/snacks/food items
- Fancy clothing
- Hammocks
- Any items brought that cause or contribute to disruption may be taken away for the duration of camp and returned to the camper at check out.

**Medication:**

- Please keep an amount appropriate for the duration of camp in original packaging placed inside a zip lock bag; this will be kept and distributed by the camp nurse.

**Notes:**

1. Try to pack as light as possible.
2. Put any liquid items in plastic zip lock bags including sunscreen to prevent spillage.
3. Cameras (not an electronic smart device) are permitted but are not needed.
4. Any type of electronic smart device will need to be checked in at the camp office for the duration of the day and will be returned at check out.
5. Money is not required on this trip, but if desired, please don't bring excessive amounts as it is the youth's responsibility to keep track of it.
6. If in doubt and not addressed on this list, please double check with camp staff before bringing an item.
