

Ozaukee County 4-H Camp Staff Position Descriptions

All staff, youth and adults, are responsible for creating a safe and supportive environment for campers by leading educational theme programs, serving as campfire leaders, and participating in camp planning meetings. This volunteer role is a valuable leadership opportunity, requiring commitment, teamwork, and dedication to fostering a positive camp experience.

Youth Adventure Camp Director (11th grade and above)

Leads the Adventure Camp program with support from the 4-H Educator and Volunteer Adventure Camp Director. Supervises Activity Leaders, assists in planning and leading camp activities and excursions, and serves as a liaison between campers, counselors, and staff. Demonstrates leadership, enthusiasm, and a commitment to creating a safe and engaging camp experience. Facilitates pre-camp planning meetings to ensure program success.

Youth Adventure Camp Activity Leader (9th grade and above)

Plans and leads camp activities that align with the program's theme while fostering leadership and skill development among campers. Supports and mentors younger participants, collaborates with camp staff to maintain a cohesive program, and prioritizes safety and enjoyment in all activities.
