- Updates from the board
 - Spending Down Plan
 - Lisa Fellenz moved that in the interest of our continued youth support and needing to spend down our money as per Extension directives, knowing that we would like these funds to support our OZ county youth, to donate the in total existing Baird account at the time of transfer and an additional \$50,000 to immediately follow to the Ozaukee County 4-H Foundation, Deanna Lee seconded, unanimously approved
 - Mary Hamm motioned that the Ozaukee County Leader's Association pay each Ozaukee County 4-H club and chartered group that requests a need for funding up to \$500 per year, Jacqueline P. seconded, unanimously approved
 - Lori Hosseini motioned that the Ozaukee County Leader's Association pays the invoice from the county from any rented space for any Ozaukee County 4-H clubs and chartered group, Dan Paulus seconded, unanimously approved
 - Rose Paulus motioned that after any fundraiser ran by the Ozaukee County 4-H Leader's Association is complete that ²/₃ of the profited money will automatically get donated to the Ozaukee County 4-H Foundation, (with the exception and after all expenses have been paid out, ex. \$5,000 will be pulled out from the Haunt for scholarships), Deanna Lee seconded, unanimously approved
 - Discussion regarding improving/updating county fairgrounds
 - County is in charge of these pieces
 - Would have to go through the specific channels
 - Flagpole project is going to possible be in works during the Haunt
 - Agreement with the Ozaukee County Foundation
 - Deanna Lee moved that in the best interest of continued youth support for our OZ county youth, that we discuss and move forward with a partnership agreement with the Ozaukee County 4-H Foundation, Rose Paulus seconded, unanimously approved
 - Policies
 - Went through the coming changes from Abi Quinlin, in above educator report
 - MOU with the County
 - MOU document had been reviewed and double checked, now implemented that the document will stand/roll over unless either party chooses to terminate or ask for review/changes to be made

- Bylaw changes
 - Abi drafted/revised the LA bylaws to show what changes will be taking place by chartering as of September 1st, 2025
- Goals:
 - The Leaders Association will provide any club or project leader who is interested in guidance on our consistent accessible platform (google) through two workshops held during the 4-H year of 2024-2025.
 - To spark interest in 4-H, our members will develop a marketing resource that highlights member learning, service activities, and how to join 4-H by August 2025. The advertisement/commercial/pamphlet that will be distributed/displayed at locations, like The Rivoli, Ozaukee Family Services, Family Sharing, Ozaukee Food Alliance, Habitat for Humanity, and Family Promise of Ozaukee, etc., which serve community members not generally familiar with 4-H, by August of 2025.
